Goofy Pencil Caddy

Homework is fun when your favorite Disney pal, Goofy, is there to lend a hand. Turn a recyclable plastic cup container into a Goofy pencil caddy!

Time: 25 minutes

What You'll Need

- Clean, empty plastic cup container
- Black cardboard
- Felt (black, white, and tan)
- Tacky glue
- Pair of scissors
- Pencil

How To Make It

- 1. Start with a clean, empty plastic cup container. Make sure to remove the excess canister if any.
- 2. Cut a strip of cardboard 13cm wide. Spread glue on the back of the cardboard and wrap it around the container, covering it. You may need more than one piece of cardboard to cover the whole perimeter.
- 3. Print the template, cut out the shapes and trace them on the felt. Use black felt for Goofy's ears, eyes, and nose. Use the white felt for his eyes and teeth, and tan felt for his muzzle. Glue the teeth to the bottom of Goofy's muzzle.
- 4. Glue Goofy's features to the container. Glue the whites of his eyes first, then his muzzle and teeth, and then his pupils and nose.
- 5. Glue Goofy's ears to the sides of the canister with a thin line of tacky glue.
- 6. Let the glue dry, and fill your caddy with pencils and pens.

Important: Cutting should be done by an adult.
